As enacted, exempts an affiliate of a business licensed under state insurance laws and a person or entity providing certain service contracts, or an affiliate of the person or entity, from requirements governing businesses that make automatic renewal offers or continuous service offers to consumers.
HB0155	372	Effective date(s) 05/11/2023, 01/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 68, Chapter 140, Part 3. As enacted, requires an annual training pay bonus supplement for eligible emergency medical services personnel in the amount of \$800.
HB0284	513	Effective date(s) 03/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 5, Chapter 14; Title 6, Chapter 56, Part 3; Title 12, Chapter 3, Part 12; Title 49, Chapter 13; Title 49, Chapter 2, Part 2 and Title 54. As enacted, standardizes the thresholds for competitive sealed bids for counties, municipalities, utility districts, local education agencies, and other local governmental entities.
HB0323	377	Effective date(s) 05/05/2023, 04/01/2024, 01/01/2024, 07/01/2024, 01/01/2025	Amends TCA Title 67. As enacted, makes various revisions to present tax law.
HB0334	736	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 63. As enacted, removes certain limitations placed on a person trying to meet the educational requirement for licensure as a polysomnographic technologist by presenting proof of successful completion of an accredited sleep technologist educational program (A-STEP) that is accredited by the American Academy of Sleep Medicine.
HB0351	968	Effective date(s) 05/21/2024	Amends TCA Title 7, Chapter 53. As enacted, makes various changes to law relative to industrial development corporations until June 30, 2028.
HB0619	611	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 37. As enacted, requires the commissioner to notify the committing court at least 15 days prior to the proposed discharge of a delinquent child who was committed to the custody of the department for an indefinite time.
HB0623	510	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 56 and Title 66. As enacted, specifies that a seller of residential property is required to disclose the presence of a known sinkhole on the property prior to entering into a contract with a buyer regardless of whether the sinkhole is indicated through the contour lines on the property's recorded plat map.
HB0647	737	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 47, Chapter 18 and Section 63-2-102. As enacted, makes changes to the law regarding costs of reproduction, copying, or mailing of certain medical records.

HB0689	969	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 39; Title 40 and Title 55, Chapter 10, Part 4. As enacted, requires an officer to provide an alleged victim of certain criminal offenses with a document notifying the victim of the global positioning monitoring system used as a condition of bail.
HB0701	525	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 39 and Title 40. As enacted, adds offenses of continuous sexual abuse of a child committed on or after July 1, 2024, to the list of qualifying criminal misconduct that is sentenced to community supervision for life in addition to any other statutorily imposed punishment.
HB0817	391	Effective date(s) 01/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 2 and Title 6. As enacted, prohibits members of local governing bodies to be elected through an election procedure that requires candidates to be nominated from a district and elected at large.
HB0835	900	Effective date(s) 05/03/2024	Amends TCA Section 2-2-106 and Section 2-2-141. As enacted, requires the coordinator of elections to compare the statewide voter registration database with the department of safety database to ensure non-United States citizens are not registered to vote in this state.
HB0843	782	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 49. As enacted, revises various provisions of present law pertaining to the "Age-Appropriate Materials Act of 2022" and the state textbook and instructional materials quality commission.
HB0878	511	Effective date(s) 02/21/2024	Amends TCA Title 4; Title 29 and Title 36. As enacted, clarifies that a person is not required to solemnize a marriage.
HB0885	395	Effective date(s) 05/11/2023, 01/01/2025	Amends TCA Title 53; Title 56 and Title 71. As enacted, enacts the "Prior Authorization Fairness Act."
HB0996	970	Effective date(s) 05/21/2024	Amends TCA Title 49. As enacted, clarifies that instruction in topics related to sexual activity are generally not age-appropriate for students in grades K-5 and must generally not be taught to students in grades K-5 as part of a family life curriculum; clarifies that such prohibition does not prohibit an LEA or public charter school from providing instruction to students in K-5 on the detection, intervention, prevention, and treatment of child sexual abuse and human trafficking in which the victim is a child.
HB1012	901	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 8, Chapter 10; Title 8, Chapter 21, Part 9 and Section 65-3-118. As enacted, makes changes to law relative to certain fees collected by sheriffs and constables.
HB1015	902	Effective date(s) 05/03/2024	Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 23 and Title 66. As enacted, authorizes persons engaged in the business of towing and storing motor vehicles, or storing motor vehicles that have been towed, to remove and secure a firearm left in a stored motor vehicle if the firearm can be removed without causing damage to the motor vehicle and other conditions are met.

As enacted, creates the inmate disciplinary oversight board for the purpose of granting or denying sentence credits for good institutional behavior and determining whether sentence credits previously awarded should be removed for commission of certain disciplinary offenses.
HB1046	971	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024, 07/01/2025	Amends TCA Title 7, Chapter 53; Title 13; Title 48, Chapter 101, Part 3; Title 56 and Title 67. As enacted, enacts the "Tennessee Rural and Workforce Housing Act."
HB1060	403	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 8; Title 50; Title 62; Title 63 and Title 68. As enacted, makes changes to the Tennessee Employment Security Law relative to benefit eligibility conditions, disqualifications events, and methods for employers to report certain conduct of claimants.
HB1072	404	Effective date(s) 05/11/2023, 01/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 3, Part 25; Title 46, Chapter 6 and Title 58. As enacted, requires the department to establish an honor guard grant program to provide grants to veteran service organizations to offset expenses incurred by the organization and members of the organization's honor guard in providing military funeral honors for qualifying Tennessee veterans.
HB1119	406	Effective date(s) 05/11/2023, 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 57, Chapter 3. As enacted, authorizes wineries and farm wine producers in this state to maintain copies of their licenses, permits, and other documents electronically for purposes of establishing compliance with the law; beginning July 1, 2024, authorizes wineries and farm wine producers that hold two or more licenses or permits to choose the expiration date for such licenses or permits within certain parameters.
HB1120	67	Effective date(s) 01/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 37. As enacted, requires the department to make chaplain services available on a regular basis to juveniles who are housed in a youth development center; prohibits the department from requiring a juvenile to attend or use chaplain services; requires the department to provide annual training to youth service officers on best practices for behavior management and conflict resolution in the context of supervision of juvenile justice youth; requires the department to house children 16 years of age or older separately from younger children, unless housing the children together is necessary for the safety and well-being of the younger children or to otherwise comply with law relative to the use of seclusion at juvenile detention facilities.
HB1163	526	Effective date(s) 03/07/2024	Amends TCA Title 48 and Title 56. As enacted, enacts the "Healthcare Sharing Ministries Freedom to Share Act."

As enacted, requires the Tennessee peace officer standards and training (POST) commission to adopt guidelines and materials instructing law enforcement officers on the best practices for recognizing and responding to a medical crisis involving a person under arrest or under the care or supervision of the law enforcement officer.
HB1181	408	Effective date(s) 07/01/2025	Amends TCA Title 4; Title 12; Title 43; Title 45; Title 47; Title 48; Title 50; Title 61; Title 66 and Title 67. As enacted, enacts the "Tennessee Information Protection Act."
HB1248	972	Effective date(s) 05/21/2024, 10/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 8; Title 38; Title 39; Title 45; Title 68 and Title 71. As enacted, authorizes a financial service provider, or an officer or employee of the provider, that has reasonable cause to suspect that an elderly or vulnerable adult is the victim or target of financial exploitation, to convey the suspicion to the TBI's elder financial reporting mechanism; requires the TBI to create an elder financial exploitation reporting mechanism that accepts reports from financial institutions.
HB1482	417	Effective date(s) 05/11/2023, 01/01/2025	Amends TCA Title 40, Chapter 11, Part 4. As enacted, allows the Tennessee Association of Professional Bail Agents to provide or contract for one or more virtual classes for agents; increases the maximum amount the association may charge for eight hours of continuing education; prohibits a person from attending such continuing education classes if the person has been convicted in any state of certain offenses.
HB1535	717	Effective date(s) 04/16/2024	Amends TCA Title 29, Chapter 20 and Title 67, Chapter 5. As enacted, makes applicable to Coffee County, present law that provides that whenever Hardeman County or Cumberland County acquires property at a tax sale, a nongovernmental entity holding a vested and duly recorded contractual right to the payment of fees or assessments secured by such property retains such right; makes applicable to Coffee County, present law that limits such nongovernmental entity to only enforce such contractual rights against the applicable county through the exercise of its lien rights; provided, however, that the applicable county is liable for the payment of the fees and assessments if the county makes actual use of the property.
HB1600	973	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 18; Title 37 and Title 39. As enacted, prohibits the purchase or possession of a firearm by a person under 25 if the person was previously adjudicated delinquent for an act that, if committed by an adult, would have constituted certain offenses; allows the TBI access to juvenile court records for the limited purpose of performing a background check prior to the transfer of a firearm or to determine eligibility for a handgun carry permit pursuant to existing law.

As enacted, increases from 500 to 650 the minimum number of curriculum hours that an applicant for licensure in massage must have completed at a board-approved institution for massage, bodywork, or somatic therapy in order to be eligible for licensure under the Massage Licensure Act of 1995.
HB1613	719	Effective date(s) 04/16/2024	Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 1, Part 3. As enacted, designates "Rockin' Around the Christmas Tree" by Brenda Lee as the official state holiday song; requires the secretary of state to include the song in the Tennessee Blue Book.
HB1625	783	Effective date(s) 04/23/2024	Amends TCA Section 33-3-206. As enacted, requires a qualified mental health professional or behavior analyst to warn or protect an identified victim or group of people when the professional or analyst determines that a service recipient has communicated an intent for actual threat of bodily harm; requires the professional or behavior analyst to report such threat; provides immunity from civil, criminal, and regulatory liability for a professional or analyst who takes reasonable action to warn or protect identified victims or groups and to report such threat.
HB1631	738	Effective date(s) 04/22/2024	Amends TCA Title 39, Chapter 17, Part 13; Title 49, Chapter 1 and Title 49, Chapter 50. As enacted, clarifies that a private school serving students in any of the grades pre-K through 12 is authorized to adopt a handgun carry policy for the private school's property.
HB1639	739	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 63 and Title 68. As enacted, provides that, if an incapacitated or deceased patient has no authorized representative, the patient's next of kin will be treated as an authorized representative for the patient for the purposes of obtaining the patient's hospital records.
HB1640	784	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 16; Title 33; Title 37; Title 39 and Title 40. As enacted, enacts "Jillian's Law," which makes various changes relative to being adjudicated as a mental defective or judicially committed to a mental institution, including requiring a person judicially committed to remain committed until the competency of the person to stand trial is restored or, if competency is unable to be restored but the person no longer meets the standard, until the court with criminal jurisdiction over the charges approves a mandatory outpatient treatment plan that accounts for the safety of the community.
HB1642	612	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 40. As enacted, revises various provisions regarding pretrial release of a defendant charged with a criminal offense to require the magistrate to give first consideration to ensuring the safety of the community when determining whether to impose conditions of release or require a deposit of bail.

As enacted, requires the state to pay the cost of a court-ordered mental health evaluation and treatment for criminal defendants who have been charged with a misdemeanor and are believed to be incompetent to stand trial or for whom there is a question about mental capacity at the time of the offense.
HB1644	563	Effective date(s) 03/12/2024	Amends TCA Title 39 and Title 49. As enacted, requires each LEA, public charter school, private school, and church-related school to develop a procedure to determine the cause of a fire alarm activation, including the potential of an active shooter event; requires each LEA to coordinate with appropriate safety teams to incorporate the procedure; specifies that the procedure must be implemented no later than January 1, 2025.
HB1645	632	Effective date(s) 04/02/2024	Amends TCA Title 36 and Title 39. As enacted, expands the eligibility for filing a petition to obtain a lifetime order of protection to include victims of aggravated stalking, especially aggravated stalking, and felony harassment.
HB1647	572	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 5, Chapter 12 and Title 9. As enacted, requires all requests for amendments to county budgets by county departments and other entities to be approved by the department or entity seeking the amendment prior to being submitted to the county legislative body for consideration; applies only to counties that have adopted the Local Option Budgeting Law of 1993.
HB1648	528	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 3, Part 2. As enacted, authorizes, upon request, the department of revenue to issue lien-free salvage certificates of title to a salvage pool operator under certain circumstances.
HB1649	573	Effective date(s) 03/15/2024	Amends TCA Title 2, Chapter 3, Part 1. As enacted, requires LEAs and public charter schools of a county to be closed for instruction on presidential primary election days if the county election commission uses such schools as a polling place.
HB1651	587	Effective date(s) 03/21/2024	Amends TCA Title 3, Chapter 17. As enacted, establishes a five-day period after the effective date of this act during which a nonprofit organization may apply to operate a charitable gaming event during the annual period beginning July 1, 2023, until June 30, 2024, and beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025.
HB1659	974	Effective date(s) 05/21/2024	Amends TCA Title 8 and Title 16. As enacted, raises the base salary from \$156,024 to \$205,328 for district attorneys general and district public defenders.
HB1675	574	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Section 37-1-102 and Section 37-2-422. As enacted, expands the eligibility for reimbursement as a relative caregiver by removing the income limitations and including a relative caregiver who meets the eligibility requirements and has been awarded custody by an order of any court.

As enacted, specifies that a juvenile court proceeding may be commenced by the taking of a child into custody or the removal of custody from a parent or legal guardian; requires the juvenile court in a dependency and neglect proceeding to determine whether a parent, guardian, relative, or caregiver of the child cannot be excluded as a perpetrator of severe child abuse against the child; prohibits a juvenile court from returning a child victim of severe child abuse to the custody of a person who cannot be excluded as the perpetrator unless certain circumstances are met; makes various other changes.
HB1680	512	Effective date(s) 02/28/2024	Amends TCA Section 71-6-102. As enacted, expands the Tennessee Adult Protection Act's definition of abuse or neglect to include certain situations when an adult is unable to maintain the adult's own health or welfare.
HB1682	785	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Section 33-6-503 and Section 33-6-421. As enacted, makes changes to the law relative to emergency involuntary admission to inpatient treatment and judicial commitment for nonemergency involuntary inpatient treatment.
HB1683	575	Effective date(s) 03/15/2024	Amends TCA Section 53-11-311 and Section 63-1-164. As enacted, removes obsolete references to federal law that pertain to the prescription of certain controlled substances.
HB1687	529	Effective date(s) 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 7, Chapter 86, Part 2. As enacted, authorizes a nurse practitioner or physician assistant to perform the mandatory physical examination of a public safety dispatcher or emergency call taker if the physical examination is included in the written protocol developed by the supervising physician and nurse practitioner or physician assistant.
HB1688	530	Effective date(s) 03/07/2024	Amends TCA Title 55, Chapter 50, Part 8. As enacted, deletes the provision authorizing a municipality or county to pass an ordinance or resolution permitting a person charged with violating certain traffic ordinances or statutes to deposit the person's driver license with the court in lieu of bail.
HB1689	614	Effective date(s) 03/27/2024, 07/01/2025	Amends TCA Section 67-4-1610 and Title 68, Chapter 211. As enacted, expands the permitted uses for money received by a county for each tire sold in the county to include removal of illegally disposed waste tires from public or private property; authorizes the department of environment and conservation to provide funds to a local government for the investigation and clean-up of unpermitted waste tire disposal sites; makes other related changes.
HB1691	531	Effective date(s) 03/07/2024	Amends TCA Section 71-05-117. As enacted, requires compliance with federal law regarding third-party liability.
HB1692	740	Effective date(s) 04/22/2024	Amends TCA Title 4, Chapter 3, Part 22 and Title 10, Chapter 7. As enacted, establishes the official policy for the maintenance of records by the department of tourist development.

HB1694	532	Effective date(s) 06/30/2024, 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Section 50-3-702; Title 50, Chapter 6 and Chapter 189 of the Public Acts of 2021. As enacted, requires an employer to report to the bureau of workers' compensation each accident that results in a work-related death or personal injury within 14 calendar days of the date the employer is notified of the accident or has knowledge of the accident, whichever is earlier, instead of reporting accidents at different intervals based upon the nature of the injury and whether the injured employee is able to return within seven days of the accident; and makes other changes relative to workers' compensation.
HB1695	906	Effective date(s) 05/03/2024	Amends TCA Title 10, Chapter 7; Title 38; Title 39 and Title 40. As enacted, clarifies that the reports of county medical examiners and autopsy reports of minors whose manner of death is listed as a homicide are generally not public documents; authorizes such reports to be released or inspected if certain conditions are met.
HB1707	533	Effective date(s) 03/07/2024, 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 48, Chapter 101, Part 5. As enacted, revises various provisions regarding the regulation of charitable solicitations in this state.
HB1708	615	Effective date(s) 03/27/2024, 07/01/2024	Amends TCA Title 3, Chapter 17, Part 1 and Title 48, Chapter 101, Part 5. As enacted, revises certain fees payable to the secretary of state by certain charitable organizations; increases from \$500,000 to \$1,000,000 the amount of gross revenue received during a fiscal year to trigger certain reporting requirements; assesses a late fee per month on certain financial reports that are not timely filed.
HB1716	786	Effective date(s) 04/23/2024	Amends TCA Title 16; Title 17 and Title 40. As enacted, specifies that in a county with more than one general sessions judge in which the judicial commissioners are supervised by the general sessions judges, the management and supervision of any judicial commissioners appointed pursuant to this section must rotate between the general sessions judges having criminal jurisdiction in the county on an annual basis.
HB1717	616	Effective date(s) 03/27/2024	Amends TCA Title 40. As enacted, requires, upon request of the county legislative body, the judicial commissioners to submit any relevant information to the county legislative body at least seven days before the public hearing.
HB1733	534	Effective date(s) 03/07/2024	Amends TCA Title 4; Title 8; Title 9 and Title 12. As enacted, prohibits a state entity from submitting payment with an entity that has engaged in a cybersecurity incident on an information technology system by encrypting data and then subsequently offering to decrypt that data in exchange for a ransom payment; requires a state entity experiencing a ransom request in connection with a cybersecurity incident to immediately notify and consult with the technology and innovation division of the TBI.

HB1789	577	Effective date(s) 03/15/2024	Amends TCA Section 49-5-417. As enacted, clarifies that pleas of guilt and nolo contendere to certain criminal offenses subject an educator to automatic revocation of an educator license by the state board; specifies that criminal offenses committed in another jurisdiction that are equivalent to those that if committed in this state subject an educator to automatic revocation of an educator license similarly subject an educator to automatic revocation of an educator license by the state board.
HB1790	539	Effective date(s) 03/07/2024	Amends TCA Title 6, Chapter 56, Part 4 and Title 10, Chapter 7, Part 5.
